Alyssa's Journey – A Teen Parent Connection Success Story!

Alyssa was 16 and pregnant – with twins! She felt scared, overwhelmed, and alone. Through Teen Parent Connection's parent support groups, Alyssa found the guidance and encouragement she needed, and went on to participate in the Healthy Families program. Weekly visits from a family support worker allowed her to discuss her babies' development, set her own goals, and make progress toward self-sufficiency. Alyssa eventually worked for Teen Parent Connection as a Peer Educator for the Prevention Program,

where she visited local schools to share her personal story and emphasize the challenges of being a teen parent.

Alyssa recently graduated from college with a bachelor's degree in social work and had this to say:

"I'm now a mother of two first-graders, enrolled in a master's program, and living on my own. I truly can't imagine what my journey would have looked like without programs in my community like Teen Parent Connection."


